Brief Bios of Vestry Nominees

Judith deLuce has been a part of Holy Trinity since the 1970s when she first joined the choir under Joyce's direction and at Frank's urging. She has been a member ever since. Even during those years when she lived in Cincinnati she still attended Holy T because she never found a church whose congregation she loved as much as this one. Lately she's been thinking about the opportunities she has had to contribute to or participate in this family. She has priced items for the yard sales and helped shoppers. She has co-chaired, with Chris, two talent sales, and most recently helped run the Holy Trinity Pantry with Geoff and Stephanie. With the Wednesday night women she has helped with the Lessons and Carols parish supper; she helped on a Lenten series with Judy Evans and Annette Tomarken, and whenever she can she attends our wonderful adult forum series. As most of you know, she is not an Episcopalian, but the principles and mission of Holy T have consistently informed and enriched her life. She is eager to find more ways to contribute to a community that means so much to her.

Bruce Ford is a native Cincinnati. He resides in Shandon, Ohio and has been attending Holy Trinity since November 2009 when he returned to the Greater Cincinnati and Oxford area after being away for nearly 30 years. Bruce has been active at our church, serving on the Outreach Committee and helping with the Community Dinners. Prior to returning to this area, Bruce resided in Northwest Ohio, engaged in Pastoral Ministry for over 18 years as an ordained pastor with the United Methodist Church. Bruce is a graduate of the University of Cincinnati-Conservatory of Music, the Yale University Divinity School, and the University of Toledo College of Law.

Becky Lukens has been a member of Holy Trinity for many years, and she has served a term on the vestry. A retired professor of English, she has over the years been an active volunteer in Habitat for Humanity, Planned Parenthood of Butler County, The Oxford Crisis Center and the Institute for Learning in Retirement.

Dan Pratt started going to Holy Trinity periodically a year ago. He attended more frequently in May and has continued since then attending regularly. He was introduced to Holy Trinity through Devin Rodgers. His background has been in the fundamental Christian faith, and although he had stopped attending a particular church over the past few years due to conflicts with some of their beliefs, he has always maintained his faith and relationship with God. Dan was raised in Hamilton, Ohio and moved outside Oxford a few years ago in order to have a small hobby farm. He currently raises llamas, horses, donkeys, goats and chickens. He currently works for the Hamilton, Ohio Police Department and is a lieutenant on the department. He has a BS in Accounting from Miami University, and as is apparent, did not choose that as his career. He has volunteer experiences such as serving as a board member on Transitional Living, a non-profit organization that serves the homeless and mental health individuals. He also volunteered as a paramedic for four years on a life squad.
